FE-II(P) 17/2015 2882 /W., Pursuant to recommendation of the Odisha Public Service Commission , Cuttack vide their letter No. 5888 Dt 26.09.2016 the following 4 (four) candidates are provisionally appointed as Assistant Architect in Class-II (Group-B) of Odisha Service of Architect under Works Department in the Scale of Pay of Rs 9,300/- - 34,800/- with Grade Pay of Rs 4,600/- with usual D.A. and other allowances as admissible from time to time with the following terms and conditions.

1. The appointments are purely on temporary basis and likely to be permanent.
2. The appointment can be terminated on one month's notice from either side without assigning any reason thereof.
3. The candidates appointed to the service shall be on probation for a period of 2 years from the date of their joining in the grade/ service.
4. The inter-se-seniority of the Assistant Architect shall be determined in order of merit as assigned to them in OPSC merit list.
5. Appointments are subject to verification of their character and antecedents in terms of G.A. Department Resolution No. 34438 dt 20.11.1999. In case any adverse report is received, the services of the candidates concerned shall be terminated forthwith in accordance with the provisions laid down in Sub Clause (ii) of Clause (h) of explanation u/r 13 of the Odisha Civil Service (Classification, Control & appeal) Rules, 1962.
6. No TA/DA is allowed to appointees to join in their place of posting.
7. She/he should swear an oath of allegiance to the Constitution and give a declaration to the effect that She/ he is not prosecuting studies in any institution at the time of joining.
8. She/he should give a declaration to the effect that she/he doesn't have more than one spouse living at the time of joining.
9. The appointees should join in the O/o the Chief Architect within 15 days from the receipt of the appointment order failing which the appointment order shall be cancelled.
